Interns must be high school juniors or seniors that are at least 17 years old

Internship opportunities are available in-person, remotely, or in a hybrid format Provides students with valuable exposure to career opportunities, helping them make informed decisions about career and educational pathways

> Students must complete a total of 200 hours over an 8 week internship
